MODULE TWO

Learning Outcomes, Feedback and Assessment

OUTLINE

The module takes place on one half day (3 hours).

This module addresses the differences in assessment practices across cultures and provides practical guidance for establishing learning outcomes and assessment criteria in an international context. It will provide insight into international students' perceptions and expectations as regards assessment. It will also look at the important role of feedback in teaching and learning.

The module will provide an opportunity for participants to present and potentially re-work their own assessment criteria and learning outcomes.

At the end of the module participants will be aware of:

- different assessment practices across cultures;
- how to set down learning outcomes and assessment criteria in an international context;
- functional language for learning outcomes, assessment and feedback;
- how to give effective feedback and support.
