Subject: Presentation of the exhibition *Terra Promissionis. Maps and views of Jerusalem and classical Palestine*, within the International Conference *Talking About the Holy Land: Pilgrim Guidebooks and Travelers' Tales from the Middle Ages to Modern Times*

Milan, May 20<sup>th</sup> 2019

The International Conference *Talking About the Holy Land: Pilgrim Guidebooks and Travelers' Tales from the Middle Ages to Modern Times* is coming, hosted by the Catholic University of Milan and the Braidense National Library from June 3<sup>rd</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup>.

Eight centuries after the visit of St. Francis in the East, 21 speakers from prestigious Italian and foreign universities will talk about Holy Land's pilgrimages from many points of view, combining narratives and experiences.

A fascinating theme, because it describes with a historical and multidisciplinary approach the encounter with a distant reality, offering important perspectives even about the difficult coexistence of today.
