EUGENIO CORTI INTERNATIONAL PRIZE

2019 Edition









1. The Research Center Letteratura e Cultura dell'Italia Unita of the Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore of Milan, with the support of the Eugenio Corti Association, has organized an **International Prize** to honour the memory of Eugenio Corti and to promote the study of his works.

2. The Prize has two parts:

a) **Prize for the best pubblication** (monograph, critical essay, philological edition) on the works of Eugenio Corti, amounting to $2,000 \in$ (two thousand euros).

b) **Prize for the best Bachelor's, Master's or PhD thesis** dedicated to Eugenio Corti, amounting to $1.000 \notin$ (one thousand euros).

3. The following are admitted to section a) of the Prize: only already printed published works, in paper or digital form, regularly indicated with an ISBN or ISSN code, published starting from January 1st 2016. Neither self edited editions nor *pro manuscripto* editions nor draft editions will be taken into consideration.

4. The following are admitted to section b) of the Prize: all doctorate thesis, thesis written at the end of the first three year university course (Bachelor's) or for a Master's degree, presented starting from academic year 2014/2015. The contestants will therefore have to show the certificate, issued by the university, stating that they have completed their relevant university degree course. Theses still to be discussed or in the making are not accepted.

5. Enrolment is free of charge.

6. Both **Italian and foreign contestants** can participate and the theses and published works may be written in languages other than Italian.

7. Given the wide-ranging different approaches and topics tackled by Eugenio Corti in his works, **there are no limits to the fields and disciplines** of the above-mentioned published these and publications.

8. For each of the two sections, at the sole discretion of the Jury, the Prize may also be awarded *ex aequo*, in the event of works or theses which are equally deserving, or not awarded at all if none of the works or thesis are considered to be worthy of the Prize. In the latter case, the prize money not granted in one section of the Prize, may eventually be passed on to the other section, if the relevant conditions were to arise.

9. The competing works or thesis will have to be forwarded in pdf format to the Prize Sectratariat (e-mail address: **elena.rondena@unicatt.it**) by Sunday October 28th 2018, at 23:59:59 hours.

10. The prize giving ceremony will take place on February 4th 2019 at the Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore of Milan during which the winners will have the chance of presenting, in brief, the results of their research work.

11. The participating works and these will be assessed by a qualified Jury composed of five specialists, set up by the *Steering Committee of the Research Center* on the basis of the following criteria : a) at least one of the members must be appointed by the *Eugenio Corti Association*, b) at least one of the members must be a member of the *Research Center*, c) at least three members must belong to the university world, of whom at least two must belong to the Italian Studies deptartment (scientific disciplines unit L-FIL - LET/10/11/12/13/14, d) at least one member must be of non-Italian nationality.

12. Over and above the Prize's two sections, the Jury may attribute one or more special prizes, following the proposal of third party entities and with their own funds.
